



## SNOW DOG

Height 20cm (8")

**KD**  
kawaii designs

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Abbreviations:

dc – double crochet (US terms sc)

inc – increase

invdec – invisible decrease (insert hook, yarn over, insert hook in next dc yarn over, yarn over and pull through all 3 loops)

Magic loop – this starting method gives a neat finish.

### YOU WILL NEED:

3mm hook & 2mm hook

Stitch marker

1 x 50g white dk

Oddments of green, brown, blue

A little bit of orange, pink, brown & black embroidery thread

1 x pair 8mm

Toy stuffing.

Notes: this pattern is made using the amigurumi method by working in continuous rounds without closing off each round, therefore we recommend you use a stitch marker on the first stitch of each round moving it up as you work.

### THIS PATTERN IS WRITTEN USING UK TERMINOLOGY

#### BODY

Using white make a magic loop with 6 dc

**Round 1:** inc into every st (12 sts)

**Round 2:** (1 x inc, 1 x dc) x 6 (18 sts)

**Round 3:** (1 x inc, 2 x dc) x 6 (24 sts)

**Round 4:** (1 x inc, 3 x dc) x 6 (30 sts)

**Round 5:** (1 x inc, 4 x dc) x 6 (36 sts)

**Round 6 to 9:** dc in every st (36 sts)

**Round 10:** (1 x invdec, 1 x dc) x 4, dc in remaining 24 sts (32 sts)

**Round 11:** dc in every st (32 sts)

**Round 12:** (1 x invdec, 1 x dc) x 4, dc in remaining 20 sts (28 sts)

**Round 13:** dc in every st (28 sts)

**Round 14:** (1 x invdec, 1 x dc) x 4, dc in remaining 16 sts (24 sts)

**Round 15 to 16:** dc in every st (24 sts)

**Round 17:** (1 x invdec, 4 x dc) x 4 (20 sts)

**Round 18 to 22:** dc in every st (20 sts)

**Round 23:** 2 x dc, 3 x inc, 5 x dc, (1 x invdec, 1 x dc) x 3, 1 x dc (20 sts)

**Round 24:** 14 x dc, 2 x invdec, 2 x dc (18 sts)

Stuff

**Round 25:** (1 x invdec, 1 x dc) x 6 (12 sts)

**Round 26:** (1 x invdec) x 6 (6 sts)

Fasten off and leave a long thread.



## HEAD

Using white make a magic loop with 5 dc

**Round 1:** inc into every st (10 sts)

**Round 2:** inc into every st (20 sts)

**Round 3 to 5:** dc into every st (20 sts)

**Round 6:** (1 x inc, 2 x dc) x 4, dc in remaining 8 sts (24 sts)

**Round 7:** (1 x inc, 2 x dc) x 4, dc in remaining 12 sts (28 sts)

**Round 8 to 9:** dc into every st (28 sts)

**Round 10:** (1 x inc, 3 x dc) x 4, 12 x dc (32 sts)

**Round 11 to 14:** dc in every st (32 sts)

Place the eyes into position. Put them just above the nose section and approx 3-4 sts apart

**Round 15:** (1 x invdec, 2 x dc) x 8 (24 sts)

**Round 16:** dc in every st (24 sts)

**Round 17:** (1 x invdec, 2 x dc) x 6 (18 sts)

**Round 18:** (1 x invdec, 2 x dc) 4, 2 x dc (14 sts)

**Round 19:** (1 x invdec) x 7 (7 sts)

**Round 20:** (1 x invdec) x 3 (4 sts)

Fasten off and sew up the hole.

Using orange embroidery thread sew on a nose.

Using brown embroidery thread sew on a line under the nose

Using black embroidery thread sew on eyebrows



## TONGUE

Using pink embroidery thread and 2mm hook, chain 3

**Row 1:** Starting 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook, dc in remaining 2 sts

**Row 2:** 1 x invdec

Fasten off and sew under the line on the face

## DEERSTALKER HAT

Using green make a magic ring with 6 sts

**Round 1:** inc in every st (12 sts)

**Round 2:** (1 x inc, 1 x dc) x 6 (18 sts)

**Round 3:** (1 x inc, 2 x dc) x 6 (24 sts)

**Round 4:** (1 x inc, 3 x dc) x 6 (30 sts)

**Round 5:** (1 x inc, 4 x dc) x 6 (36 sts)

**Round 6:** (1 x inc, 5 x dc) x 6 (42 sts)

**Round 7:** dc in every st (42 sts)

**Round 8:** (1 x invdec, 5 x dc) x 6 (36 sts)

**Round 9 to 11:** dc in every st (36 sts)

you will now work in rows to do the ear flaps starting with the right flap

**Row 1:** dc in the next 4 sts, ch 1, turn

**Row 2:** 4 x dc, ch 1, turn

**Row 3:** repeat row 2

**Row 4:** 2 x invdec

Fasten off

Now count across 15 sts and re-attach the yarn to the 16th st.

Repeat row 1 to 4.



Attach brown to the 15 sts between the ear flaps.

**Row 1:** dc in the 15 sts, ch 1, turn

**Row 2 to 3:** dc in every st, ch 1, turn

**Row 4:** 1 x invdec, 11 x dc, 1 x invdec, ch 1 turn (13 sts)

**Row 5 to 8:** dc in every st (13 sts)

**Row 9:** 1 x invdec, 9 x dc, 1 x invdec, ch 1, turn (11 sts)

**Row 10:** 1 x invdec, 7 x dc, 1 x invdec, ch 1, turn (9 sts)

fasten off.

Place the hat on the head – the ear flaps will represent the snow dogs ears, tack the hat on the head.

## TAIL

### Main Branch

Using brown make a magic ring with 5 dc

**Round 1 to 10:** dc in every st (5 sts)

Fasten off and leave a thread to attach to body.

### Little Branch

Using brown make a magic ring with 5 dc

**Round 1 to 3:** dc in every st (5 sts)

fasten off and leave a thread to attach to the main branch.

Sew the little branch on the 5<sup>th</sup> row of the main branch.

Bend the top of the main branch.

Now sew onto the top of body at the back.



## BACK LEGS (make 2)

Using white make a magic loop with 4 dc

**Round 1:** inc in every st (8 sts)

**Round 2:** (1 x inc, 1 x dc) x 4 (12 sts)

**Round 3:** (1 x inc) x 3, 9 sts (15 sts)

**Round 4:** dc into every st (15 sts)

**Round 5:** (1 x invdec, 1 x dc) x 3, 6 x dc (12 sts)

**Round 6 to 7:** dc in every st (12 sts)

**Round 8:** (1 x invdec, 3 x dc) x 2, 2 x dc (10 sts)

**Round 9 to 10:** dc all round (10 sts)

add stuffing into the foot and shape

**Round 11:** (1 x invdec, 3 x dc) x 2 (8 sts)

**Round 12 to 14:** dc in every st (8 sts)

add a little stuffing into the leg

**Round 15:** (1 x invdec) x 4

Fasten off, leave a long thread for sewing onto the body.

Sew the back legs with side of the body in a straight down position.



### FRONT LEGS (make 2)

Using white make a magic loop with 5 dc

**Round 1:** inc in every st (10 sts)

**Round 2 to 8:** dc in every st (10 sts)

**Round 9:** (1 x invdec, 3 x dc) x 2 (8 sts)

**Round 10 to 13:** dc in every st (8 sts)

add a little stuffing to the foot end

**Round 14:** (1 x invdec) x 4 (4 sts)

Fasten off, leave a long thread for sewing onto the body.

Sew the front legs either side of the front of the body, these need to be positioned so they are going forward (refer to the pictures for reference)



### SCARF

Using blue chain 51 sts

starting 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook dc in every st, ch 1, turn (50 sts)

Row 1: dc in every st, ch 1, turn

Rows 2 to 4: repeat row 1

Fasten off.

Now sew the head into position. Don't worry if it doesn't sit back just yet, once you have it on the body wrap the scarf around the neck. Once the scarf is on you can tip the head back so your snow dog is looking up and tack the hat onto the body, so it stays in this position.

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
