

EASY CROCHET STINGRAYS


Abbreviations:
dc - double crochet
hdc - half double crochet
trb - treble
dtrb - double treble
tptrb - triple treble
inc - increase
invdec - invisible decrease (insert hook, yarn over, insert hook in next dc yarn over, yarn over and pull through all 3 loops)
ch - chain
Magic loop - this starting method gives a neat finish.
You will need
3 mm hook
$1 \times 100 \mathrm{~g}$ dk yarn main colour
$1 \times 50 \mathrm{~g} \mathrm{dk}$ bottom colour
$1 \times 25 \mathrm{~g} \mathrm{dk}$ spots
Toy stuffing
12 mm eyes
White thread for eyes

Notes: this pattern is made using the amigurumi method by working in continuous rounds without closing off each round, therefore I recommend you use a stitch marker on the first stitch of each round moving it up as you work.

## THIS IS WRITTEN IN UK TERMINOLOGY

BODY (make 2 - one in main colour and one in bottom colour)
Chain 7
Row 1: starting in the third ch from hook hdc in every st ( 5 sts), ch 2, turn
Row 2: $1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 3 \mathrm{xhdc}, 1 \mathrm{xinc}(7 \mathrm{sts})$, ch 2 , turn
Row 3: $1 \times$ inc, $2 \times \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 2 \mathrm{xhdc}, 1 \times \mathrm{inc}(10 \mathrm{sts})$ ch 2 , turn
Row 4: $1 \times$ inc, $8 \times$ hdc, $1 \times$ inc ( 12 sts ) ch2, turn
Row 5: $1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 3 \times \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 2 \times \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 3 \times \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \times \mathrm{inc}(16 \mathrm{sts}) \mathrm{ch} 2$, turn
Row 6: $1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 14 \times \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \times \mathrm{inc}(18 \mathrm{sts})$ ch 2 , turn
Row 7: $1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 16 \times \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \times \mathrm{inc}(20 \mathrm{sts}) \mathrm{ch} 2$, turn
Row 8: $1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 18 \times$ hdc, $1 \times \mathrm{inc}(22 \mathrm{sts})$ ch 2 , turn
Row 9: $1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 20 \times \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \times \mathrm{inc}(24 \mathrm{sts})$ ch 2 , turn
Row 10: $1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 22 \mathrm{xhdc}, 1 \times \mathrm{inc}(26 \mathrm{sts}) \mathrm{ch} 2$, turn
Row 11: $1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 24 \mathrm{x}$ hdc, $1 \times \mathrm{inc}(28 \mathrm{sts}) \mathrm{ch} 2$, turn
Row 12: $1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 26 \mathrm{xhdc}, 1 \mathrm{xinc}(30 \mathrm{sts}) \mathrm{ch} 2$, turn
Row 13: $1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 28 \mathrm{xhdc}, 1 \times \mathrm{inc}(32 \mathrm{sts}) \mathrm{ch} 2$, turn
Row 14: $1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 30 \mathrm{xhdc}, 1 \times \mathrm{inc}(34 \mathrm{sts}) \mathrm{ch} 2$, turn
Row 15: $1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 32 \times$ hdc, $1 \times \mathrm{inc}(36 \mathrm{sts}) \mathrm{ch} 2$, turn
Row 16: $1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 34 \mathrm{x}$ hdc, $1 \mathrm{xinc}(38 \mathrm{sts})$ ch 2 , turn
Row 17: $1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 36 \mathrm{xhdc}, 1 \mathrm{xinc}(40 \mathrm{sts}) \mathrm{ch} 2$, turn
Row 18: $1 \mathrm{xinc}, 38 \mathrm{x}$ hdc 1 x inc ( 42 sts ) ch 2 , turn
Row 19: $1 \times$ inc, 40 x hdc, 1 x inc ( 44 sts ) ch 2 , turn
Row 20: $1 \times$ invdec, $40 \times \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \times \mathrm{dec}$ ( 42 sts ) ch 2 , turn
Row 21: 1 xhdc in every stitch ( 42 sts ) ch 2 , turn
Row 22: 1 x invdec, $38 \mathrm{xhdc}, 1 \mathrm{x}$ invdec ( 40 sts ) ch 1 , turn
Row 23: $1 \times$ invdec, $1 \times \mathrm{dc}, 6 \mathrm{xhdc}, 6 \times \operatorname{trb}, 4 \times \mathrm{dtrb}, 2 \times \operatorname{tptrb}, 4 \times \mathrm{dtrb}, 6 \times \operatorname{trb}, 6 \times \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \times \mathrm{dc}, 1 \times$
invdec ( 38 sts), ch 1, turn
Row 24: $1 \times \operatorname{invdec}, 1 \times \mathrm{dc}, 5 \times \mathrm{hdc}, 8 \times \mathrm{trb}, 5 \times \mathrm{dtrb}, 8 \times \mathrm{trb}, 6 \times \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \times \operatorname{invdec}(36 \mathrm{sts}) \mathrm{ch} 1$, turn
Row 25: $1 \times$ invdec, $5 \times \mathrm{dc}, 8 \times \mathrm{hdc}, 5 \times \mathrm{trb}, 8 \times \mathrm{hdc}, 6 \times \mathrm{dc}, 1 \times \operatorname{invdec}(34 \mathrm{sts}) \mathrm{ch} 1$, turn
Row 26: $1 \times$ invdec, $8 \times \mathrm{dc}, 14 \times \mathrm{hdc}, 8 \times \mathrm{dc}, 1 \times \operatorname{invdec}(32 \mathrm{sts})$
Leave the main one attached to the yarn. Fasten off the bottom one.
Place the eyes on the main colour part. Approx between the $5^{\text {th }}$ and $6^{\text {th }}$ row and 6 sts apart.

Using the yarn still attached to the blue body and with right side facing dc around the edges of both the bodies. Leave a gap to stuff then continue until closed.

EYE LIDS (make 2)
Using main colour chain 6 sts
Row 1: starting $2^{\text {nd }}$ chain from hook dc in remaining sts ( 5 sts)
Row 2: $2 \times \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{x}$ inc, $2 \times \mathrm{dc}$ ( 6 sts )
Fasten off, fold in half lengthwise and sew then sew above the eyes. Using white sew a couple of lines of white right under the eyelids.

FRONT PRONGS (make 2)
Using main colour make a magic ring with 3 sts
Round 1: $1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 1 \times \mathrm{dc}, 1 \times \mathrm{inc}(5 \mathrm{sts})$
Round 2: dc in every st ( 5 sts )


Round 3: $(1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 1 \times \mathrm{dc}) \times 2,1 \times \mathrm{inc}(8 \mathrm{sts})$
Round 4: $(1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 2 \times \mathrm{dc}) \times 2,1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 1 \times \mathrm{dc}(11 \mathrm{sts})$
Round 5: $(1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 2 \times \mathrm{dc}) \times 3,2 \times \mathrm{dc}(14 \mathrm{sts})$
Round 6 \& 7: dc in every st ( 14 sts)
Fasten off
Add a little bit of stuffing. Sew up the end and then sew onto to the body.

## TAIL

Using main colour make a magic ring with 4 sts
Round 1: $(1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 1 \times \mathrm{dc}) \times 2$ ( 6 sts )
Round 2: $(1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 1 \times \mathrm{dc}) \times 3$ ( 9 sts )
Round 3: $(1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 1 \times \mathrm{dc}) \times 4,1 \times \mathrm{dc}(13 \mathrm{sts})$
Round 4 to 23: dc in every st ( 13 sts)
Fasten off, stuff, sew up the end and sew into the centre of the body at the back.

## SPOTS (make 8)

Using your spot colour make a magic ring with 5 sts
Round 1: inc in every st ( 10 sts )
Round 2: $(1 \times \mathrm{inc}, 1 \times \mathrm{dc}) \times 5$ ( 15 sts )
Fasten off. Sew them onto the top of the body as shown in picture

Finishing touch: using black yarn turn your stingray
 over so you see the white belly. Sew on three lines for its gills. See picture for reference
